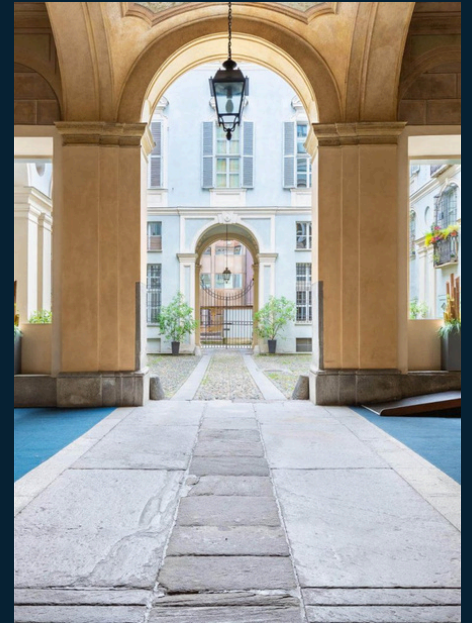


# About Fondazione dell'avvocatura torinese Fulvio Croce

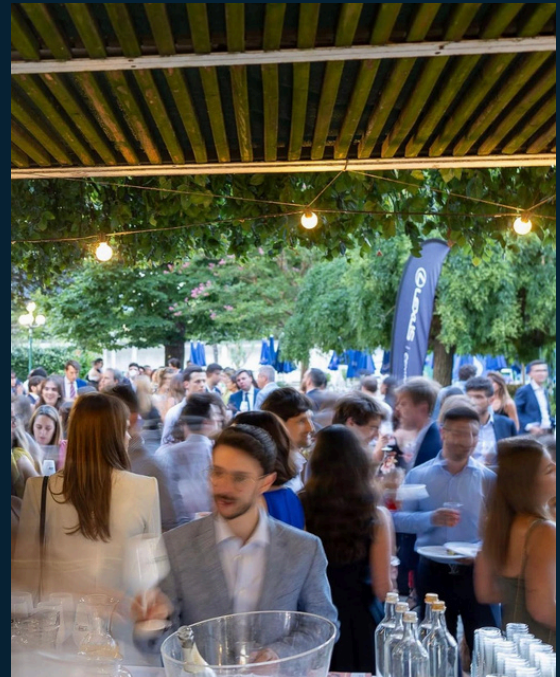
